

This is the second part of the new three-part series on the latest member of your Lottery Director software -- your 'Fast Track' Game Manager.

In the last issue, you saw the options on your 'Fast Track' program's Main Menu. On that menu, you can view any game -- or you can scan all of the games automatically. You can generate reports for those games.

In this new issue, you'll see how to view the reports that the 'Fast Track' program makes. You'll use the Management Menu to do this.

If you'd like to follow along in the program as you use this newsletter, here's how:

- Start your 'Fast Track' Game Manager. Just use the 'Fast Track' selection on your Lottery Director starting menu.
- You'll see your 'Fast Track' Main Menu. Select any game file. (We are using your Practice Program in this newsletter.)
- You should see Screen 1 for your game. (See the example in the next column on this page.) Now, follow the tips in this newsletter -- and enjoy your program!

Viewing the 'Fast Track' Reports

When you select a single game, you'll see a series of screens for that game.

- Use your mouse, PageUp, or PageDown to 'scroll' through the screens.
- Pressing F1 will display 'Help'.
- Pressing F2 will print the information, and will advance you to the next screen.

Note that you do not use the 'Fast Track' program to enter your game's new draws. Use your Lotto program to update the game.

You have twelve screens -- *explore them!* You'll see summaries of: Wins; Trending, Overdue, and Consistent numbers; Groups; Sums, Even/Odd, Low/High, and Repeats; Consecutive numbers; and other factors.

Making Single Game Reports

In addition to the screens, you can view or print a complete report for your game. Here's how to do it.

Press your Escape key to exit the screens. You'll return to your Main Menu.

On your Main Menu, select either of these two choices:

- **B Make Brief Report:** This gives you a report with all the 'screen' information.
- **D Make Detailed Report:** You get a report with all the 'screen' information, plus a list of the last 50 to 200 draws.

To View or Print a Report: Choose one of the reports above. Next, you can print it. Then you can view it -- like this:

Go to your 'Fast Track' Management Menu (see the example -- top of the next column.)

Here is the 'Fast Track' Management Menu:

On this menu, select this option:

- **D View Database Reports:** You'll see the report on your screen. It will be either the 'Brief' or 'Detailed' report -- whichever one you have just made.

Making Multiple Game Reports

You can also get reports for multiple games. This is a very useful and powerful tool -- because now you can compare your game against similar games. Here's how to do it.

Return to your 'Fast Track' Main Menu. Select either of the following choices:

- **C Make Combined Report:** This will make a combined report for all games. The report will be made automatically.
- **I Make Internet Report:** This will make separate reports -- one for each game. The reports will be made automatically.

To View Multiple Reports: Just return to your Management Menu. Then select:

- **C View Combined Reports:** You'll see a menu for Pick-6 games, Pick-5 games, and so on. Select the games you want, and you'll see their combined report.
- **I View Internet Reports:** You'll get a menu listing each game. Select the game you want, and you'll see its report. You can also use your Windows-based Internet Browser to view these reports.
